

Borough of Forest Hills Auxiliary Aid & Service Policy

The Borough of Forest Hills will provide appropriate auxiliary aids and services to qualified individuals with disabilities whenever necessary to ensure effective communication between the Borough and members of the public during public meetings, unless doing so would fundamentally alter the nature of the Borough's services, programs or activities or would result in an undue financial and administrative burden to the Borough.

Qualified individuals with a disability that require an appropriate auxiliary aid or service to participate in a Borough public meeting must contact the Borough Manager, Steve Morus, by telephone at 412-351-7330 or in writing at 2071 Ardmore Boulevard, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15221 as far in advance of the public meeting as possible, but no later than five (5) business days prior to the public meeting.
