FOREST HILLS COUNCIL SEEKS RESIDENTS TO FILL BOARD VACANCIES

Forest Hills Borough Council seeks volunteers to serve on several boards and committees beginning in March 2010 unless otherwise noted. The terms of several current members are about to expire and Council is interested in determining the names of citizens who are willing and able to serve.

Any Forest Hills citizen interested in serving on a committee, commission or board should forward a letter of application along with a recent resume or biography to the Borough Office, 2071 Ardmore Blvd, Pittsburgh, PA 15221 and indicate "volunteer" in the bottom left corner of the envelope. Applications should be submitted to the borough office no later than 4:00 PM Wednesday, January 6, 2010 although applications will be accepted until positions are filled.

Current volunteers whose terms are expiring must contact the Borough Office to indicate their interest in reapplying for the position. Committees, Commissions and Boards with vacancies include the following (although applications for membership on any borough committee will be accepted):
