Old Business: Cindy reported that the engraved bricks at the pool will be put in sometime this Spring. Keith and Jamie suggested a trial period for the Doggie Park this Spring. There was some discussion as to whether or not residents should be required to pay a small fee for tags identifying those permitted to use the park. If a dog is found not to have a tag they could be fined. Cindy stated that an ordinance would be needed to do this and it would be up to Council to address. Jamie and Keith agreed that they would send an email with ideas on the park and talk to council with a target date of March or April.

Barry suggested a one time two week pass at a special rate. After some discussion it was agreed that this may be too confusing.
