

**Recreation Board Minutes  
February 7, 2011**

January minutes were accepted. (Galloway/Finlay)

**Swim Report:** Ed told the board that he has received permission from the borough to hang a swim team banner on Ardmore Blvd. at the bottom of Yost Blvd. He said that the team has not yet received its schedule from the ESA, but there will be fewer home meets this year. Home meets will all be on Tuesday evenings.

**Tennis Report:** Oksana told us she has not contacted the USTA about information on the 50/5 grant to help pay for the resurfacing of the tennis courts. She will report back on the information next month. Andrea said that Mark Paull will sponsor the Lady Lobsters in order to qualify for this grant.

Andrea asked Oksana about the court lights. Oksana said we need new fixtures. Andrea suggested redirecting the lights. Cheryl asked why we can't just get the existing lights working properly. Cindy said that this issue is on the council agenda. Cindy said that she put \$75,000 in the 2011 Capital Budget for the resurfacing and it was approved. She explained that even though the item was approved, that does not necessarily mean the money is there for the project. Andrea said she would check with Woodland Hills High School for information on the resurfacing project they are currently undertaking. Cheryl would like to put together a tennis court renovation committee.

**Parks Report:** None

**Marketing and Events Report:** Cindy informed us that Fun in the Park has been cancelled due to insufficient staff and lack of registration.

Cindy presented the board with her new dress code policy for the pool staff. This policy will be sent to the staff along with their hiring letters.

Cindy also told us that council is discussing residents sponsoring non-residents for pool memberships. They will be charged a higher fee and will need a letter of recommendation from a resident who has lived in the borough for at least five years. The solicitor is currently investigating such a policy. She said they are just exploring options at this point in time and it is not something that would happen this year.

Cindy also advised the board that Melissa Bell is interested in becoming a board member in April.

Lynn informed the board that the summer concert will be held on Friday, August 19<sup>th</sup> and will feature the band Dr. Zoot.

**Old Business:** Adult Winterfest was discussed. Ed said David Fink would be happy to take flyers to local businesses to advertise the event. It was decided that money should be collected at the door. Ed said he would provide a cash box and change. Board members agreed to take turns collecting the money. Cheryl said she would provide tablecloths, decorations, forks, cups, etc... Ed said he would bring a CD player and

firewood for the fire pit that Cheryl was going to bring. Set up will be at 2pm the day of the event.

**New Business:** Andrea asked if we wanted to vote on new officers or wait until more members and possible candidates were available. We decided it can be voted on next month.
