Marketing and Events Director' Report: Cindy reported that some of the copy for the brick fundraiser did not fit in the space available. She sent letters to the residents and asked them to shorten their message and resubmit the request.

Old Business: Brick project-nothing new other than decision to use area next to entrance walkway for the placement of the bricks.

Dog Park at Ryan Glen-Cheryl presented the board with a letter from approximately two years ago from area residents stating that they had no interest in a dog park in their area. They were concerned about increased traffic, parking problems, strange dogs from other neighborhoods, and clean up after the dogs. Cheryl will speak to neighbors to see what their interest is at this point regarding the doggie park. Jamie suggested we try a trial period, possibly in the upper field area of the park that is seldom used. Jamie and Keith will continue to work on a proposal and Jamie will speak with solicitor regarding liability issues.

AED-Keith reported that the grant application was received and it will be 3-4 months before the money is approved. Lynn raised concerns regarding the pool running through the summer without an AED. Keith assured the board that EMS response is within 1 or 2 minutes and there should not be a huge risk to patrons of the pool. Keith will put out feelers for a loaner for the pool this summer.
