At its regular meeting to be held on Wednesday, December 21, 2016, at 7:00 PM, in Council Chambers at the Forest Hills Borough Building, 2071 Ardmore Boulevard, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15221, the Council of the Borough of Forest Hills will hold a public hearing on and thereafter consider the adoption of, and if appropriate enact, the following proposed ordinance entitled:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FOREST HILLS,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING
STERLINGWOOD POINT ROAD.**

This proposed ordinance vacates Sterlingwood Point Road, a paper street in the Borough laid out on property located on or about Sherwood Road, currently designated as Allegheny County Block and Lot Nos. 299-F-62, 299-F-64-1, 299-F-66-1, 299-F-68, 299-F-68-1, 299-F-78, 299-F-76 and 299-F-70, by the Scherbick – Scolieri Plan of Lots, as recorded in the Office of the Department of Real Estate of Allegheny County in Plan Book Volume 166, page 129; authorizes appropriate Borough officials and employees to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the vacation of the portion of Sterlingwood Point Road; repeals any prior inconsistent ordinances; and establishes the ordinance's effective date.
