Our mobile clinic, staffed by compassionate caregivers, will provide low-to-no-cost veterinary care services, health support, and a welcoming space for pet owners. Our clinics are designed to serve underserved individuals across the Greater Pittsburgh Region who face financial hardships and various social challenges. These challenges, including housing instability and limited access to traditional care, can make it tough to have a furry companion.
