

CDC/Forest Hills Guidelines for the Forest Hills Pool -- 2020

- The borough is planning to open the pool on **Monday, June 22 at 10:00 a.m.** Please follow the social distancing that we will have in place.
- If you have already purchased a pool pass, those will still be honored. As in the past, your tags will be at the pool on June 22 and thereafter.
- If you would like to purchase a pool pass, a revised pool application is now on the website. Please follow the instructions and submit your application and payment to the borough office.
- Because the office is still closed, please put your application and payment in the overnight box and address the envelope to Cindy Simm, Recreation Director.
- We will still charge daily admission at the pool, and those discounted prices are listed on the pool application.
- Also, this season, we will not be offering swim lessons, plus packages, or the sponsorship program. There will be no swim or synchro teams this season. If you have already submitted payments for these programs, you will receive a refund.
- This season, only Forest Hills residents will be admitted to the pool. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult. Photo ID will be required.
- We will also implement a **pre-registration** system that will begin **Monday, June 22 from 8:00 to 10:00 a.m.**

Pre-registration

- Pre-registration for visiting the pool will start **Monday, June 22**, you will call the pool office, 412-241-2525 on that day between the hours of 8:00 to 10:00 a.m. and speak with the pool manager or the assistant pool manager.
- You will then be given a timeslot to come to the pool that day – which will be for 2-1/2 hours. Once that timeslot is taken, you will not be able to change your registration.
- We will also be taking names for a waiting list in case there are any timeslots that are still open after 10:00 a.m.
- This pre-registration will be done every day, and the names on the waiting list will not transfer to the next day, so you will have to call every day to reserve your slot.
- When you arrive at the pool, you will be required to sign-in and show Photo ID. You will also be required to sign a waiver to gain entrance to the pool.
- Additional instructions are posted at the pool.
